



## How to read the Child Care Assistance Co-Pay Chart

### Child Care Assistance Co-pay Example:

The example provided here is that of a single parent with a monthly income of \$775.00

- 1. Locate your Monthly Income** – In this example the parent's Monthly Income is \$775.00 and falls between \$751 and \$801
- 2. Locate your Family Size** – In this example the parent's Family Size is 2 (parent and baby).
- 3. Follow the row for Monthly Income and the column for your Family Size. Where they meet is your potential co-pay.** Parent's potential copay would be \$18 per month.

\*More than one child:

- If more than one child, the base co-payment for each additional child are determined at one half of the co-payment for the previous child.
- Each child's co-payment will be adjusted based on the units of services, as follows:
  - full time care (30 or more hours/week) will be based on one hundred percent of the co-payment
  - part time 1 care (8 – 29 hours/week) will be based on seventy five percent of the co-payment
  - part time 2 care (8 – 19 hours/week) will be based on fifty percent of the co-payment
  - part time 3 care (7 or less hours/week ) will be based on twenty five percent of the co-payment

Co-payment Chart above reflects April 1, 2019 thru March 2020 copay rates. Co-pay rates are updated yearly and are based on Federal Poverty Level (FPL) which is adjusted annually in accordance with federal guidelines.
