Early Childhood Scholarships

Investing in early childhood professionals and their careers

The quality of New Mexico's early childhood programs and statewide system depends upon the caring, knowledgeable people who work with children and families. This is why the New Mexico Early Childhood Education and Care Department (ECECD) provides scholarship opportunities to make it possible for early educators and care providers to afford coursework leading to advanced credentials and degrees.



Benefits

- Scholarships are available to meet the needs of early childhood education and care professionals at all levels.
- Scholarship Coaches assist scholars along their career pathway.
- Create a personalized professional development plan.
- Awards include one year of funding with possibility of renewal.



Eligibility

Scholarships are based on a cost-share model and are open to New Mexico early childhood educators, administrators, and program directors who:

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent (GED/HSE).
- Are enrolled in a qualifying New Mexico higher education institution working toward an early childhood education degree or New Mexico Child Development Certificate.
- Work a minimum of 20 hours per week at a:
 - New Mexico licensed child care program;
 - State-funded PreK or early PreK program, such as Early Head Start and Head Start; or
 - State-funded home visiting or Family Infant Toddler (FIT) program.

How to Get Access

- Provide confirmation of FAFSA financial aid completion <u>bit.ly/FAFSA-financial-aid</u>.
- Once scholarship is awarded, begin work with an assigned coach.
- Remain eligible by meeting the requirements for grades and credit hours.
