- Learned about the statewide early intervention services and supports provided by the Early Intervention Program at the New Mexico School for the Deaf.
- Learned about the benefits of early intervention services from the ICC Parent Panel.
- Voted to recommend Autumn Bruton to the Governor for official appointment as an early intervention provider representative on the ICC.
- Voted to accept ICC Committee Reports.
- Discussed factors that may have contributed to the 6% drop in Early Childhood Outcome (ECO) data.
- Reviewed Annual Performance Report (APR) targets and voted to recommend that four targets remain the same and that two targets be increased.
- Learned about educational services for homeless children & youth in New Mexico.
- Discussed ICC support for FIT families coming to speak with their legislators about the importance of FIT services during Children & Youth Day at the Legislature.
- Voted to have the ICC Executive Committee consider the Cerebral Palsy Task Force recommendations specific to the FIT Program.
