helps **New Mexican families**
with the cost of child care.

WHO MAY APPLY FOR CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE?

Any parent, grandparent, or legal guardian who is working, going to school, searching for employment, in a job training program or other qualifying activities and need help paying for child care.

HOW IS ELIGIBILITY DETERMINED?

Income guidelines may be found in the Materials Library at nmececd.org/child-care-assistance/.

WHAT AGE OF CHILD QUALIFIES FOR CHILD CARE ASSISTANCE?

Any child between the ages of 6 weeks and 13 years old, or to the age 19 for children with special needs.



Apply for Services

- **Step 1:** Take the Am I Eligible Survey at eligibility.ececd.nm.gov/
- **Step 2:** Complete the five minute survey to determine which programs you may qualify for.
- **Step 3:** Apply for services and request a referral by completing the online application.

What you need to apply:

- Proof of earned or unearned income
- Birth Certificate(s) for children
- Proof of New Mexico residency
- Photo ID
- School schedule of parent if applicable
- Documentation of Custody
