- Supplements are paid out in six-month cycles.

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Bilingual Incentive-Information

- One-time payment of \$1,500
- Open to all early childhood educators who provide direct support to children ages 0-5 and are working in a qualified program.
- Bilingual certification refers to ANY additional language in which you are certified
