# **Purpose and Eligibility**

- In FY25, the New Mexico Legislature appropriated an additional \$17M to ECECD to enhance and expand the NM PreK program.
- The NM PreK Grant is a competitive, multi-year grant for the following eligible providers:
  - Local Education Agency (LEAs) or state charter school
  - Child Care (center and home-based) programs currently licensed by ECECD
  - Tribal early childhood education program
  - Head Start program (Region 11 (Tribal) and Region 6)
  - School operated by the U.S. Bureau of Indian Education (BIE)





## **NM PreK Goals**

- 1. Increase access to voluntary, quality PreK programs
- 2. Provide developmentally appropriate activities for New Mexico children
- 3. Focus on school readiness
- 4. Expand early childhood community capacity



## Submission of a complete grant application is required

- New Programs
- Renewal Requests
- Expansion Requests
- Basic (Half Day) to Extended (Full Day) Conversion Requests

## **Conversion and Enrollment Reduction**

 Current PreK providers can submit a formal letter to request a conversion or enrollment reduction

Conversion or Enrollment Reduction letters must be on district/program letterhead and contain the following:

- Current program option(s)
- Requested changes to program option or type
- Rationale for program changes including a description of community collaboration

### Program Types

- **Basic PreK:** 540
- Extended PreK: 1080 instructional hours
- Extended Plus PreK: 1380 instructional hours

### **Program** Options

- Early PreK (3s)
- Mixed PreK (3s and 4s)
- PreK (4s)



### **Per-Student Rates**

<b>Extended</b> (1,080 hours of instruction; 90 hours of parent engagement)	\$12,300	\$10,300
<b>Extended Plus</b> (1,380 hours of instruction; 90 hours of parent engagement)	\$15,750	\$14,300

• Support for extended instructional hours

• Salary parity built into rate

 Allow for substitutes while teachers participate in professional development and coaching

# Maximizing and Leveraging Head Start Programs

Dual Enrollment Extended Option	This option is for Head Start programs to extend to 1080 instructional hours annually and dually enroll Head Start children in NM PreK	Programs will receive reimbursement for the difference between their current Head Start Rate per child and the 3-year-old mixed age rate (\$12,300)
Dual Enrollment Extended Plus Option	This option is for Head Start programs to extend to 1380 instructional hours annually and dually enroll Head Start children in NM PreK	Programs will be paid the difference between their current Head Start Rate per child and the 3-year-old mixed age rate (\$15,750)
Blended Enrollment Extended Option	This option is for Head Start programs to dually enroll Head Start children in NM PreK and serve non-Head Start NM PreK children within the same classroom for 1080 instructional hours annually.	Programs will be paid the difference between their current Head Start Rate per child and the 3-year-old mixed age rate (\$12,300) AND each NM PreK-only slot will receive the full 3-year-old/mixed age rate
Blended Enrollment Extended Plus Option	This option is for Head Start programs to dually enroll Head Start children in NM PreK and serve non-Head Start NM PreK children within the same classroom for 1080 instructional hours annually.	Programs will be paid the difference between their current Head Start Rate per child and the 3-year-old mixed age rate (\$15,750) AND each NM PreK-only slot will receive the full 3-year-old/mixed age rate

## **Expanding Early PreK Across the Mixed-Delivery System**

ECECD will prioritize funding PreK applications based on the following categories and saturation. "Saturation" refers to the number of slots in Head Start and New Mexico PreK available within the geographic boundaries of a school district.

- Priority 1: NM School District Areas that do not have any School or Community-based NM PreK slots.
- **Priority 2:** NM School District Areas that do not have any School or Community-Based NM Early PreK Slots or serve less than 75% of four-year-olds.
- Priority 3: NM School District Areas with less than 25% saturation of NM Early PreK slots
- Priority 4: NM School Districts that have between 25-50% saturation of NM Early PreK slots
