All early childhood professionals working in licensed child care, community-based PreK, home visiting, and Family Infant Toddler (FIT) providers are required to create a PDIS profile.

PDIS lets you track your education, credentials, required trainings, and wages in one convenient place — giving you a clearer picture of your professional journey. Program directors enroll as administrators; all other early childhood professionals create individual profiles.
